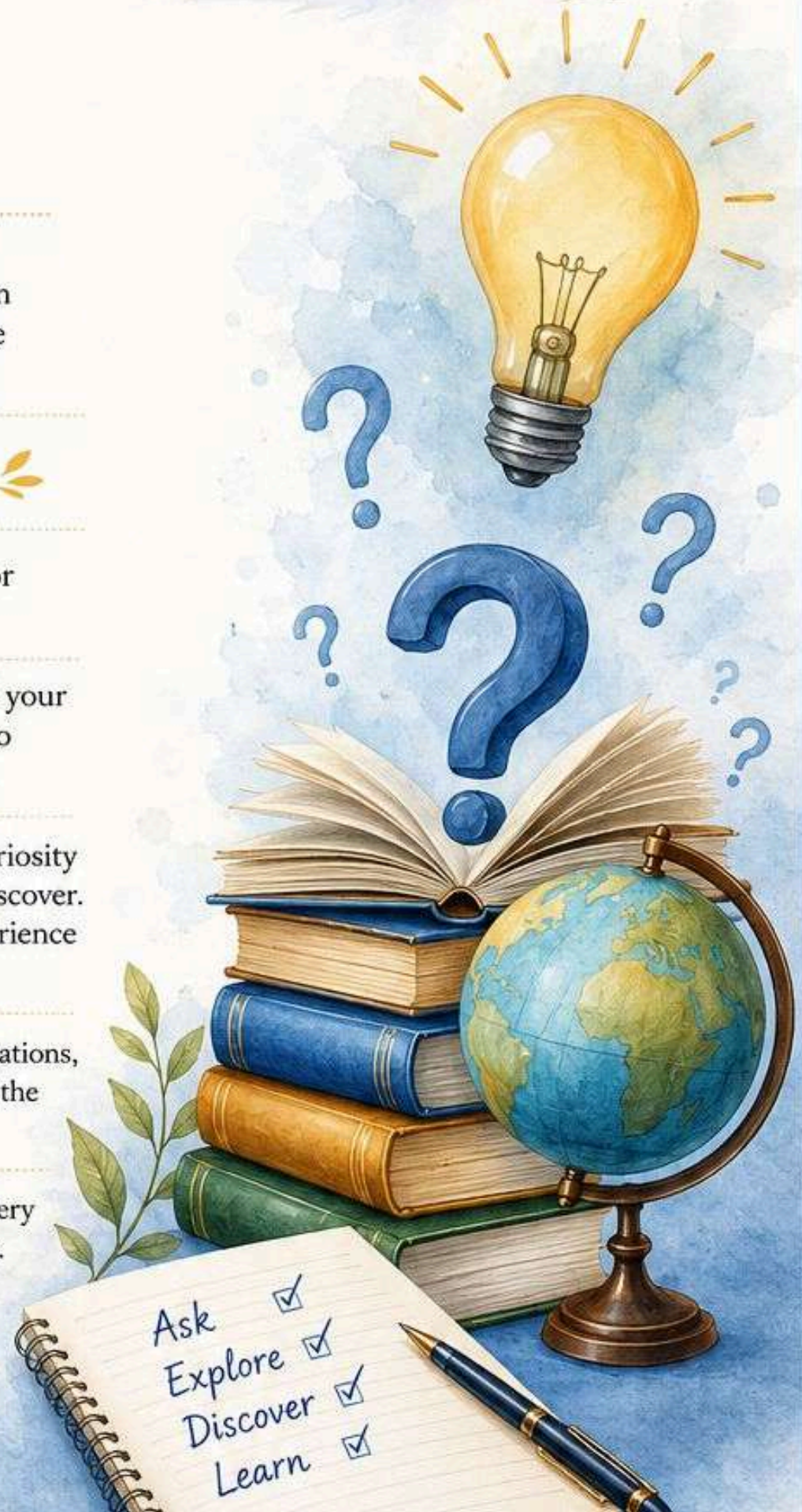
As a school, our aim is not only to prepare children for examinations, but also to prepare them for life. And a curious mind is one of the greatest tools they can carry with them.
